This program can be considered a basic building block of code enforcement education. The seminar focuses on the basic concepts of the 2006 IBC. These concepts provide a basis for the design professional's correct utilization of the code in all facets their job. A clear understanding and correct utilization of the identified requirements allows the professional to apply the code in clear-cut situations and helps build an understanding of the intent of the code when asked to make a judgment on code compliance.

The course will also help the design professional to correctly locate and recognize the interrelatedness of code requirement, as well as to begin to develop a procedure to approach code enforcement. It will address the organization of the code book the interrelatedness of the IBC with the family of ICC codes and will briefly identify code changes in certain topic areas.

Objectives:

- Locate general topics (chapters) in the 2006 IBC.
- Locate specific tables in the 2006 IBC for applicable situations.
- Identify code requirements applicable to real world situations.
- Discuss the intent behind a given code requirement.
- Interpret requirements for a scenario as compliant or noncompliant
