ICC Instructor, John M. Gibson, Jr., M.C.P., C.B.O., C.P.C.A., C.F.I., will review the 2003 International Residential Code. A certified Master Code Professional; he has forty other certifications. Having earned a B.S. in Engineering from the University of Delaware, he has also studied Architecture at Georgia Tech and completed courses in Emergency Management and Fire Prevention at the National Emergency Training Center. Formerly the Director of the Department of Permits and Inspections for Frederick County Maryland, he has served on the Board of Directors for BOCA International, Inc., the ICC- Evaluations Services (ICC- ES) Board of Directors, the ICC Code Correlating Committee, Maryland's Governors Smart Code Strategy Group, Chaired the ICC Board for International Professional Standards and is a Past President of the Maryland Building Officials Association. Working with Mr. Gibson is Development Ombudsman for Prince William County, Jamie Slapinski, and Paul Lynch, Director of Residential Inspections Division for Fairfax County. They will review the 2003 International Residential Code, tailoring their presentation to Virginia codes for residential construction. Ms. Slapinski is a Virginia Licensed Architect and a member of the Virginia Building and Code Officials Association. Mr. Lynch is a certified instructor with the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development, and a Certified Building Official.
